INSTRUCTIONS TO AUTHORS

The *Macedonian Journal of Animal Science* (*Maced. J. Anim. Sci.*) is an official publication of the Institute of Animal Science. It is published twice a year. The journal publishes **original scientific papers**, **short communications**, **reviews**, **professional** and **educational papers** from all fields of animal sciences.

This journal also publishes, continuously or occasionally, the bibliographies of the members of the Institute, book reviews, reports on meetings, information on future meetings, important events and dates, and various headings which contribute to the development of the corresponding scientific field.

Original scientific papers report unpublished results of completed original scientific research. Experimental data should be presented in a way that enables reproduction and verification of analyses and deductions on which the conclusions are based. Manuscripts should normally not exceed 6000 words.

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The **names of chemical substances** should be in accordance with the *Le Système Internationale d'Unitès* – SI.

Formulas and equations. Chemical equations should be balanced and numbered consecutively along with mathematical equations or other mathematical expressions. All of them should be marked with Arabic numerals in parenthesis in the right hand margin. The use of equation editor (Word) for typesetting the equations is recommended. Strokes (/) should not be used instead of parentheses.
